ORDINANCE No. 187717

Amend Utility License Law to include direct access electric services and establish minimum penalties for certain violations. (Ordinance; amend Code Sections 7.14.040 and 7.14.110)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. In 2002, the Oregon legislature amended state law to allow large commercial businesses to buy electricity directly from alternative electric suppliers ("ES"), rather than exclusively from regulated electric utilities. The option of receiving market-based services from an ES is called Direct Access. Commercial customers similarly have access to natural gas services from third party providers. There are several Direct Access suppliers currently providing services to commercial customers within Portland. The City's Utility License Law does not currently address the provision of services by Direct Access suppliers as constituting operating as a utility within the Code definitions. Thus, revenues associated with Direct Access sales within Portland are not captured through utility license fees.
- 2. The cities of Hillsboro and Prineville previously amended their city codes to address direct access services provided to customers within their city limits. Staff recommends that the Council amend the City Code to provide tax parity among competitive providers of services operating within the City.
- 3. The Utility License Law addresses the assessment of civil penalties for violations of the code based upon a percentage of a utility's gross revenues. Amending the Utility License Law to require a minimum penalty of \$500 or 2% of gross revenue would provide a more efficient and appropriate administrative approach. The Utility License Law should also be revised to conform to the notice provisions in the Business License Law regarding notice of potential assessment of civil penalties.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. Chapter 7.14, Utility License Law, is amended as set forth in Exhibit A attached to this ordinance.
