

ORDINANCE No. 187718

Authorize a contract with the lowest responsive bidder for the construction of the Cured In Place Pipe Southeast Rehabilitation Project No. E10682 for \$2,260,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Approximately 6,570 feet of deteriorating combination sewer located throughout the East Willamette area will be rehabilitated. The boundaries of the project span from I-84 on the north, SE Claybourne St. on the south, SE 72nd Ave. on the east and SE 44th Ave. on the west.
2. Environmental Services along with Kennedy/Jenks Consultants has prepared plans and specifications for rehabilitating the deteriorated sewer pipe, including sewer manholes and service laterals.
3. The estimated cost is \$2,260,000. The level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FYs 2016, and 2017 Budgets, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10682

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

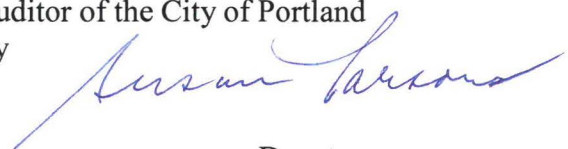
- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute a contract for the purpose described in Section 1, with the lowest responsive bidder.

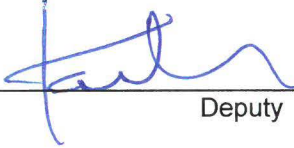
