ORDINANCE NO. 117679

An Ordinance vacating a certain portion of N. Olympia Street from the west line of Nlock 1, Happy Day Addition extended northerly to the east line of said Block 1, Happy Day Addition, extended northerly, under certain conditions.

WHEREAS the Council finds that under date of gept. 20, 1963, Ronald W. and Betty Carlson, 9566 N. Tloga Avenue, Portland, and Earl F. and Theata J. Schucker, 9585 N. Buchanan Street, Portland petitioned the Council for the vacation of a certain portion of N. Olympia Street from the west line of Block 1, Happy Day Addition extended northerly to the east line of said Block 1, Happy Day Addition extended northerly, in the City of Portland, County of Multnoman, State of Oregon, pursuant to the applicable provisions of ORS 271.010 et seq., and thereupon the City Auditor gave notice by posting and by publication of a notice once each week for five successive weeks that said petition had been filed for the vacation of said street area; that the matter of said vacation together with any objections, remonstrances or claims for damage which might be made in writing and filed with the City Auditor prior to the time for hearing would be heard and considered by the Council at a meeting to be held at 9:30 A.M., October 30, 1963, in the Council Chambers of the City Hall, in the City of Portland, Oregon; that said notice was first published in the City's official newspaper, to wit: the Daily Journal of Commerce, September 27, 1963, and said Auditor within five days after the first publication further published said matter by posting three notices headed "Notice of Street Vacation" in three (3) conspicuous places in the area proposed to be vacated, in the following described locations:

Location

Object to Which Attached

At the approximate intersection of the north line of N. Olympia Street and the east line of N. Tioga Avenue

On a stake

On the approximate south line of N. Olympia Street approximately 100 feet east of the east line of N. Tioga Avenue

On a tree

At the approximate intersection of the north line of N. Olympia Street and the west line of N. Buchanan Avenue

On a pole

and

WHEREAS said matter came on regularly for hearing October 30, 1963, and no one appeared to object thereto and no objections, remonstrances or claims for damage were made or filed against the same, and

WHEREAS the abutting property owners have consented to said proposed vacation and such consents have been filed with the City Auditor, and more than two-thirds of the area inside the district has been found to be represented as consenting, and

WHEREAS the Council further finds that the proposed vacation has been investigated by the City Planning Commission and by the City Engineer, each recommending that the petition be granted subject to certain conditions, which conditions and portion to be vacated are set forth in the City Engineer's report dated September 17, 1963, and hereinafter set forth, and

WHEREAS the purpose of this vacation is for residential purposes, the same as the adjacent ground, and more particularly for yard purposes, and to enclose an area for private use; and

WHEREAS the Council finds that the vacation of said area as outlined below will not injuriously affect the market value of the property abutting or affected by such vacation, but such vacation is in the public interest and said vacation in all respects will be for the public welfare, and the Council further finds that all things have been done as provided by law for the vacation of said street area and that final action should now be taken thereon and such vacation made a matter of record; now, therefore

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. It hereby is ascertained and determined that said vacation will not injuriously affect the market value of any of the property abutting upon said street area to be vacated, but will be beneficial thereto; that the owners of property abutting upon said area to be vacated will not be damaged by said vacation; that notice has been duly and regularly had; that the consents of the owners of all the property abutting such area to be vacated has been obtained in writing, duly acknowledged and filed as hereinabove stated; that no claims for damage were made or filed against said vacation and that the public interest will not be prejudiced thereby, but that said vacation will enhance the public interest and welfare, all of which determinations hereby are made a matter of record.

Section 2. There hereby is vacated all of the following described property in the City of Portland, County of Multnomah, State of Oregon:

All that portion of the southerly 31.62 feet of N. Olympia Street lying between the northerly extension of the east and west lines of Block 1, Happy Day Addition.

subject, however, to the following conditions:

1. That the petitioners deposit the sum of \$300 with the City Treasurer in Trust Fund for charges for sidewalk repair as the estimated cost of closing the curb, constructing sidewalk and repaving at the N. Tioga Avenue-N. Olympia Street Intersection

and that at the completion of this work according to plans set forth by the City Engineer and at the expense of the petitioners, the said sum of \$300 will be refunded.

- 2. That petitioners pay all costs incidental to this vacation.
- Nothing herein contained shall cause or require the removal or abandonment of any sewer, water or gas main, conduit of any kind, wire, pole or thing used, or intended to be used for any public service, and the right hereby is reserved for the owner of any such utility or thing to maintain, continue, repair, reconstruct, renew, replace, rebuild, and/or enlarge any and all such things; that no building or structure of any kind shall be built or erected within a distance of ten feet from the center line of any such utility, except with the written consent of the City Engineer, and the owner of such utility first had; and that any and all contemplated building plans in said vacated area shall be submitted for approval to the City Engineer and to the Director, Bureau of Buildings, to the end that such construction may be so adjusted with reference to all public utilities in said area as to cause a minimum of danger or inconvenience to the public and to the owner of such utility and to protect and preserve the same as presently constructed or hereafter reconstructed, renewed, replaced and/or enlarged.

Section 3. Petitioners shall file with the Auditor of the City of Portland an acceptance of the vacation, approved by the City Attorney as to form, and the Auditor shall file for record with the County Clerk who is ex-officio recorder in and for Multnomah County, State of Oregon, a certified copy of this ordinance and a certified copy of said acceptance as provided by law, and shall file copies with the County Assessor and the County Surveyor of said county.
