ORDINANCE NO. 177712

An Ordinance designating portions of underground wiring Control District A to be served by Pacific Power & Light Company and Portland General Electric Company respectively and exempting electric utility service within said Control District A from the provisions of Section 12 of Ordinance No. 86333, passed by the Council December 3, 1947, granting a franchise to Pacific Power & Light Company, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that a special underground wiring control district is being established by amendment to the Public Works Code whereby an orderly program of underground conversion should be followed in such special control district to permit the most economical, practical and reasonable provision of underground utility facilities rather than overhead utility facilities in said area; that among others, said amendment to the Public Works Code effects Pacific Power & Light Company and Portland General Electric Company; that in order to facilitate the program of conversion to underground of electric service in said area and in order to permit said electric utilities to arrange their facilities for such conversion, they have determined upon the areas within said special control district which should be served exclusively by each company; that said exclusive service will provide economies to the respective companies and are in the public interest; that therefore such exclusive character of service should provide an exemption from provisions of Section 12 of Ordinance No. 86333, passed by the Council, December 3, 1947, which granted a franchise to Pacific Power & Light Company; now, therefore, the electric service within Control District A established by amendment to the Public Works Code described as follows shall be provided exclusively by Portland General Electric Company:

Beginning at a point on S. W. Jefferson Street at S. W. 6th Avenue; thence west along S. W. Jefferson Street to the east line of the Oregon State Highway Commission right of way designated for the Stadium Freeway; thence southerly and southeasterly along said easterly line of said Stadium Freeway right of way to S. W. 4th Avenue; thence northerly along S. W. 4th Avenue to S. W. Harrison Street; thence west along S. W. Harrison Street to S. W. 5th Avenue; thence north along S. W. 5th Avenue to S. W. Mill Street; thence west along S. W. Mill Street to S. W. 6th Avenue; thence north along S. W. 6th Avenue to S. W. Jefferson Street, the point of beginning; and

Beginning at a point on S. W. Jefferson Street at S. W. Harbor Drive; thence west along S. W. Jefferson Street to S. W. 1st Avenue; thence south along

S. W. 1st Avenue to S. W. Market Street; thence east along S. W. Market Street to S. W. Harbor Drive; thence in a northerly direction along S. W. Harbor Drive to S. W. Jefferson Street, the point of beginning.

Section 2. Electric service shall be provided exclusively by Pacific Power & Light Company within the following described portion of said District A:

Beginning at a point on S. W. Jefferson Street at S. W. 1st Avenue; thence west along S. W. Jefferson Street to S. W. 6th Avenue; thence south along S. W. 6th Avenue to S. W. Mill Street; thence east along S. W. Mill Street to S. W. 5th Avenue; thence south along S. W. 5th Avenue to S. W. Harrison Street; thence east along S. W. Harrison Street to S. W. 4th Avenue; thence north along S. W. 4th Avenue to S. W. Market Street; thence east along S. W. Market Street to S. W. 1st Avenue; thence north along S. W. 1st Avenue to S. W. Jefferson Street, the point of beginning.

Section 3. Either or both Portland General Electric Company or Pacific Power & Light Company shall provide electric service in the following described portion of said District A, with duplications to be eliminated to the extent feasible.

Beginning at a point on S. W. Madison Street at S. W. Harbor Drive; thence West along S. W. Madison Street to S. W. Broadway; thence north along S. W. Broadway to S. W. Yamhill Street; thence west along S. W. Yamhill Street to the easterly line of the Oregon State Highway Commission right of way designated for the Stadium Freeway; thence southerly along said easterly line of said Stadium Freeway right of way to S. W. Jefferson Street; thence east along S. W. Jefferson Street to S. W. Harbor Drive; thence northerly along S. W. Harbor Drive to S. W. Madison Street, the point of beginning.

Section 4. The area within said Control District A established by amendment to the Public Works Code hereby is exempted from the provisions of Section 12 of Ordinance No. 86333, passed by the Council, December 3, 1947.

Section 5. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that conversion to under-

ground facilities of all public utilities within an additional downtown area set forth by amendment to the Public Works Code as Control District A may be furthered and facilitated; therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
