

Dear Commissioner Bean:

Returned herewith are the letter and plan from the architects for the new gymnasium at Benson High School which indicates a need for the use of park property in vacated N.E. Glisan Street.

A revised set of plans was exhibited to me in the Park Bureau office on July 17th by Mr. Bloodworth, one of the architects, and it appears that the changes in the ramp which you suggested have been made.

I advised Mr. Bloodworth that official sanction by Council action would be necessary before any construction could be undertaken on park property, and that he should urge the School District to submit a formal request for an easement immediately.

The Park Bureau recommends that upon the receipt of a formal request, the permission be granted.



## ORDINANCE NO. 118906

An Ordinance granting a revocable permit to School District No. 1, Multnomah County, to construct, maintain and use access facilities on a strip of Park Bureau property in Buckman Field adjoining the Benson High School Gymnasium, upon certain conditions, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that School District No. 1, Multnomah County, by L. J. Baker, Business Manager, has requested permission to use a strip of Park Bureau property on the North side of Buckman Field to construct access facilities to the Benson High School Gymnasium Building; that the Superintendent of the Bureau of Parks has recommended that the request be granted and the same has been approved by the Commissioner in charge of the Bureau of Parks; now, therefore, a revocable permit hereby is granted to School District No. 1, Multnomah County, by L. J. Baker, Business Manager, 620 N. E. Halsey Street, to use certain property owned by the City of Portland in Buckman Field and to construct thereon facilities for access to and egress from the Benson Polytechnic High School Gymnasium Building, all in accordance with the drawing attached to the original only of this ordinance, marked Exhibit "A," and by this reference made a part hereof.

Section 2. The permit granted in Section 1 of this ordinance shall be subject to the following conditions:

- (a) This permit is revocable at any time at the pleasure of the Council and no expenditure of money hereunder or lapse of time, or any other act or thing shall operate as an estoppel against the City of Portland, or be held to give the grantee any vested right or other interest in the property for which said permit is granted. Upon revocation of this permit by the Council, the grantee shall within 60 days remove the said improvements from the park area as required by and to the satisfaction of the Superintendent of the Bureau of Parks.
- (b) The grantee shall hold the City of Portland, the Superintendent of the Bureau of Parks, and each and all of the officers and employes of said city free and harmless from any claims for damages to persons or property which may be occasioned by any



construction, maintenance and/or use of park area under the permit hereby granted.


- (c) The grantee herein shall file an acceptance of the terms of this ordinance in writing, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that there may be no delay in providing authority for construction of said facility which will improve the property and is in the public interest; therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
