ORDINANCE No. 123958

An Ordinance granting a revocable permit to Pacific Power & Light Company to install and maintain an underground electric vault on city-owned property in Block 132, City of Portland, to be used in conjunction with the Public Auditorium, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that in connection with the newly remodeled Public Auditorium and the relocation of property lines due to certain street vacations that Pacific Power & Light Company has requested permission to install and maintain an underground electric vault to be located in Block 132, City of Portland, Multnomah County, Oregon; now, therefore, a revocable permit is hereby granted to Pacific Power & Light Company to install and maintain an underground electric vault at the site of the Public Auditorium, being Block 132, City of Portland, Multnomah County, Oregon, in such location and in accordance with Pacific Power & Light Company's drawing No. PA-22598, a copy of which is attached to the original only of this ordinance and by this reference made a part of this ordinance.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that there may be no unnecessary delay in commencing construction of the facilities for use in connection with the Public Auditorium; therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
