Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

This ordinance amends an agreement with TriMet for Capital Improvements for Safe Access to Transit. The agreement integrates the desires of TriMet and the City to work together to facilitate the use of Rectangular Rapid Flash Beacons at locations that they believe will improve pedestrian visibility and safety.

The City and TriMet are amending the agreement to allow time to continue to work together to provide safe access to transit by extending the termination date of the agreement until July 1, 2018.
