## ORDINANCE No.

\*Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the NE 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue: I-84 Ramps to NE Skidmore St project for an estimated \$1,720,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- As part of the 2015-16 one-time General Fund authorization, the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) will be constructing pavement maintenance work on NE 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue from I-84 ramps to NE Skidmore St. Work includes striping for buffered bike lanes, pedestrian signal improvements at various intersections, and upgrading ramps to meet current ADA guidelines.
- 2. The pavement condition on NE 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue has deteriorated to a point at which a 3 inch grind and overlay is now required.
- 3. Grinding and paving 3 inches at this time meets PBOT's Pavement Management strategy of performing pavement maintenance early in the lifecycle to prevent much higher rehabilitation costs in the future.
- 4. The Bureau of Transportation has general funds budgeted in FY 2015-16 and proposed FY 2016-17 for construction, inspection and management of the project.
- 5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimate for this project is moderate as the project scope is clearly understood and well defined.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to PBOT T00501 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because it is important to advertise this project as soon as possible to begin construction in the summer of 2016; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
