**Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:**

The Bureau of Transportation is seeking to formally accept a grant for the USDOT Smart City Challenge, which was accepted by the Mayor due to the tight timeline needed for execution of the document. PBOT has worked with OMF Grants Office to process and proceed in the interim to ensure all financial and reporting requirements have been met. This formal ordinance will allow for appropriate tracking within the City's financial system.

**Financial and budgetary impacts:**

\$100,000 of USDOT funding – to be formally budgeted this fiscal year in the grants fund.

**Community impacts and community involvement:**

While there is a large community involvement portion of the project should the City receive the grant, and there is an ongoing engagement of equity community partners, the acceptance of the grant itself is a technical issue.
