## ORDINANCE No. 187748

Correct and clarify Fire Regulations, and adopt 2014 Oregon Fire Code with City of Portland amendments (Ordinance; amend Code Title 31)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland is designated by the Oregon Fire Marshal as an exempt jurisdiction; therefore, Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) is responsible for administering fire regulations within its jurisdictional boundaries.
- 2. The State of Oregon has adopted the 2014 Oregon Fire Code based on the International Fire Code, 2012 edition.
- 3. The Portland Fire Marshal believes the Oregon Fire Code and International Fire Code with certain exceptions, provides adequate regulation, that its adoption will have little impact to the citizens of Portland, and there is benefit to having a uniform regulatory environment throughout the State.
- 4. The Portland Fire Marshal believes that readers of the adopted fire code would benefit by rewording and reformatting selected text.
- 5. The Portland Fire Marshal believes that aerial luminary devices should be addressed in City Code Title 31.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. City Code Title 31 is hereby amended as shown in Exhibit A.
- b. City of Portland amendments to the Oregon Fire Code are hereby adopted as shown in Exhibit B.
