

ORDINANCE No. 187757

*Authorize grant agreement with Kenton Action Plan for \$12,527 for Neighborhood Small Grants Program within the target area of North Portland Neighborhood Services to increase community involvement (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

SECTION 1. The Council finds:

1. The Neighborhood Small Grants Program provides neighborhood and community organizations an opportunity to expand their community-building capacity, attract new and diverse members and sustain those already involved.
2. These grants have contributed significantly toward increasing the improving the number and diversity of people who are involved and volunteer in their communities and neighborhoods—a key goal of the Office of Neighborhood Involvement (ONI) and this grant program.
3. This program has been adopted as part of the FY 16 ONI budget and is funded with a total of \$12,527 through City General Fund dollars.
4. Kenton Action Plan, dba North Portland Community Works, is a nonprofit organization working in collaboration with North Portland Neighborhood Services, the District Coalition office funded by ONI, to distribute small grants and provide civic engagement services within the target area of North Portland Neighborhood Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a) The Director of the ONI and the City Auditor are authorized to execute a grant agreement with Kenton Action Plan totaling \$12,527 on behalf of the City in a form substantially in accordance with Exhibit A attached as follows:
- b) Amendments to the grant agreement may be agreed to and executed by the Director of ONI or her/his designee provided those amendments do not increase the fiscal risk to the City.
- c) The Director of the ONI and the City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for said grant agreement from the Office of Neighborhood Involvement FY 16 general funds.

Section 2. The council declares an emergency ordinance exists in order to avoid interruption in the continuity of services to be provided, therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.

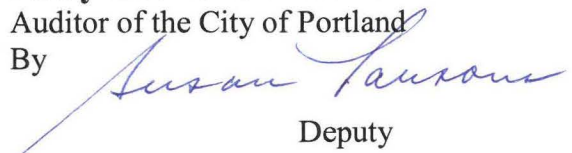
