ORDINANCE No.

* Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Clackamas County in the amount of \$60,000 for overtime costs to ensure investigators and reconstructionists are available to respond to afterhours and weekend call-outs for fatal and prosecutable crash scenes, and high-profile crashes involving city employees within the City (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Annually in the City of Portland the Major Crash Team responds to 50-60 call-outs, which result in 35-40 fatalities.
- 2. The Police Bureau has 3 crash scene reconstructionists.
- 3. The Traffic Division is committed to providing services for and overseeing special events (Rose Festival, marathons, marches, protests, dignitary visits), which require the participation of Crash Team Members. During such special events the City needs an outside agency crash team to respond to call-outs in the City.
- 4. When the Police Bureau reconstructionists are not available, or when it is necessary for an outside agency to do the investigation, the Police Bureau needs to have access to outside reconstructionists.
- 5. Clackamas County has reconstructionists available for after-hours and weekend call-outs for fatal crash scenes.
- 6. Sufficient funding resides in existing Police Bureau appropriation.
- 7. It is beneficial to the City and community that this agreement may be authorized as quickly as possible to avoid a lapse in access to this resource.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-charge is authorized to execute an agreement between the City and Clackamas County as outlined in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$60,000.
- b. The Chief of Police and the Project Manager are authorized to execute amendments to the scope of services and the terms and conditions of this Agreement including annual adjustments to the rates and not to exceed amount.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in executing this agreement may deprive the City of its benefits. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
