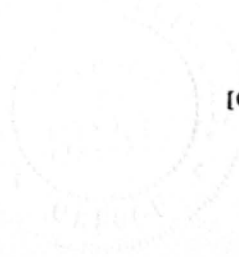

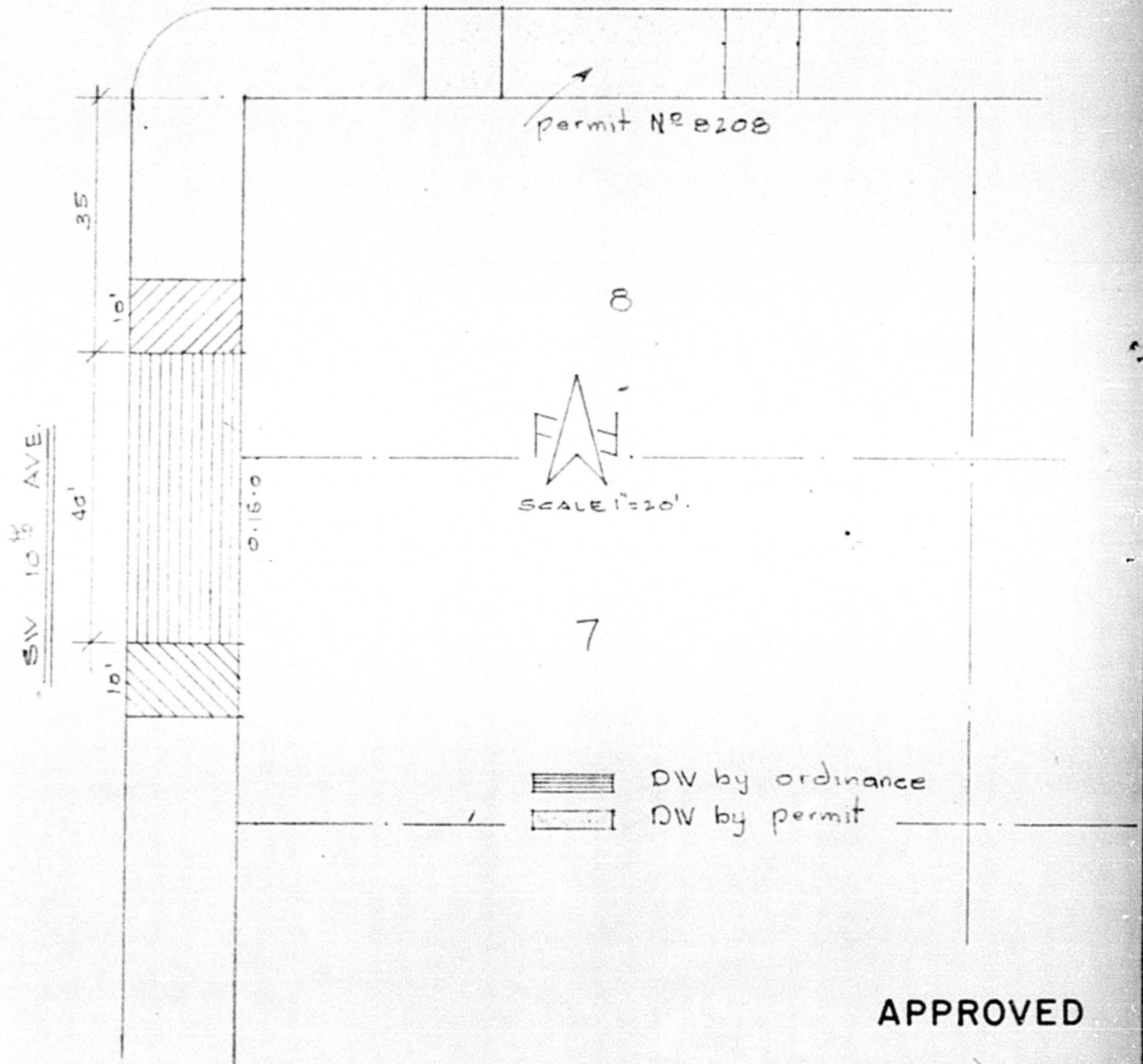



ORDINANCE NO. 125249

An Ordinance granting a revocable permit to City Center Parking Incorporated to construct and maintain a 40-foot concrete service driveway in the street area of S. W. 10th Avenue between S. W. Taylor Street and S. W. Salmon Street, waiving provisions of Section 5-902 of the Public Works Code and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. It appearing to the Council that City Center Parking Incorporated, 932 S. W. Taylor Street, Portland, Oregon, has, through Cyril Burgstahler of Burgstahler Engineers, made written application to construct and maintain a 40-foot concrete service driveway in the street area of S. W. 10th Avenue between S. W. Taylor Street and S. W. Salmon Street adjacent to Lots 7 and 8, Block 220, Portland, that said driveway violates provisions of Section 5-902 of the Public Works Code which provisions should be waived, that said driveway is needed to provide access to a parking structure and that the granting of the desired permission under certain conditions will not be detrimental to the public interest; now, therefore, a revocable permit is hereby granted to City Center Parking Incorporated (hereinafter referred to as the grantee) to construct and maintain a 40-foot concrete service driveway in the street area of S. W. 10th Avenue as hereto set forth and as shown on the attached plan marked "Exhibit A," which plan is hereby made a part of this Ordinance, waiving certain provisions of Section 5-902 of the Public Works Code, this permit being granted subject to the following conditions:

(a) That this permit is revocable at any time at the pleasure of the Council, and no expenditure of money hereunder, or lapse of time, or other act or thing shall operate as an estoppel against the City of Portland or be held to give the grantee any vested or other right. Upon revocation, the grantee shall within thirty (30) days discontinue the use of said driveway and reconstruct the sidewalk and curb as required by and to the satisfaction of the City Engineer.

(b) The grantee shall hold the City of Portland, the City Engineer, and each and all of the officers and employees of said City free and harmless from any claims for damages to persons or property which may be occasioned by any construction and/or maintenance carried on under the permit hereby granted.


(c) The grantee shall pay to the credit of the General Fund, an Engineering Fee of \$7.50, as provided by Ordinance No. 76971.

(d) This ordinance shall not become effective until the grantee shall have filed with the City Auditor a document satisfactory to the City Attorney accepting the terms and conditions hereof.


