

ORDINANCE No. 127444

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to advertise and receive proposals for furnishing all materials, equipment, tools and labor and for improving N. Lagoon Avenue from N. Channel Avenue to approximately 1,050 feet east thereof, for the Department of Public Works, on behalf of the Port of Portland, authorizing a contract therefor, authorizing the drawing and delivery of checks therefor against the Trustees' Fund, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:


Section 1. The Purchasing Agent hereby is authorized and directed to advertise and receive proposals for furnishing the necessary tools, equipment, materials and labor and for improving N. Lagoon Avenue from N. Channel Avenue to approximately 1,050 feet east thereof for the Department of Public Works on behalf of the Port of Portland, in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor filed in the Bureau of Purchases August 14, 1968, which plans and specifications hereby are adopted and by this reference made a part of this ordinance.

Section 2. The Mayor and the Commissioner of Public Works hereby are authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the responsible bidder submitting the most advantageous bid for the project mentioned in Section 1 hereof. The Council hereby reserves the right to reject any and/or all bids, in whole or in part, and in the event no satisfactory bid is received, the Purchasing Agent hereby is authorized to readvertise therefor until a satisfactory bid is received. The Treasurer hereby is authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the amount deposited by the Port of Portland in the Trustees' Fund (see Section 4-1405 of the Finance Code), when demand is presented, approved by the proper authorities.


Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: in order that there may be no delay in providing authority for the project mentioned in Section 1 hereof, therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
