NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the matters hereinbefore stated, Collins Water District, a Municipal corporation, Multnomah County, Oregon, has and by these presents does sell, assign, transfer and set over unto the City of Portland, Oregon, all of the right, title and interest of said Water District in and to all assets of the said Water District, including but not limited to the water transmission system containing mains, hydrants, valves, meters and miscellaneous items related thereto, all storage and reservoir installations and the following sums of money and accounts:

## ORDINANCE NO. 126700

An Ordinance authorizing acceptance of bill of sale, deed, assets and liabilities of Collins Water District, wholly annexed to the city, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that Collins Water District has been wholly annexed to the city by Ordinances Nos. 125245 and 125471, effective September 26, 1967, and October 31, 1967, respectively; that the officers of said District have executed a bill of sale for its assets and a bargain and sale deed for its tanksite, which should be accepted by the City; now, therefore, the Commissioner in charge of the Bureau of Water Works hereby is authorized to accept on behalf of the City a bill of sale from Collins Water District, substantially in accordance with "Exhibit A" attached hereto and by this reference hereby made a part hereof; and the bargain and sale deed substantially in accordance with "Exhibit B" attached hereto, hereby is accepted, and the City Auditor is directed to record said deed in the appropriate records of Multnomah County.

Section 2. The cash funds of the Collins Water District, consisting of \$15,379.60, have been deposited with the City Treasurer in the Trustee Fund and should be distributed; now, therefore, the City Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to distribute said cash funds as follows: \$2,176.52 to the Water Bond Sinking Fund, and the balance, \$13,203.08, to the Water Fund; and the City Treasurer hereby is authorized and directed to obtain the tax money held by the County Treasurer or in future collected for the Collins Water District tax levies, and credit it as received from time to time to the Water Fund.

Section 3. Since the City succeeds to the liabilities of the Collins Water District, as well as its assets, and since there was a contract between the City and the Collins Water District for fire protection on which the sum of \$14,391.30 is due the City for the current fiscal year, the Mayor and Auditor hereby are authorized and directed to draw and deliver a warrant for said amount of \$14,391.30 payable to the General Fund and chargeable to the Water Fund, Appropriation Other Charges (5700.690). The Bureau of Water Works hereby is authorized to transfer to the Water Construction Fund, Revenues, any funds remaining from 1967-68 receipts on the account of Collins Water District. Future tax receipts shall be credited to Water Bond Sinking Fund, Revenues, to assist in payment of bonded debt assumed by the City as successor to said District.

## ORDINANCE No.

Section 4. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order to accept assets and liabilities of Collins Water District without unnecessary delay; therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
