

ORDINANCE No. 126708

An Ordinance authorizing an agreement between the city and Southern Pacific Company to provide and install crossing gate protection at S.E. 11th and 12th Avenues and S.E. Clinton Street, providing for an allocation of costs and maintenance, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that it is desirable and in the public interest to install railroad crossing gate protection at S. E. 11th and 12th Avenues and Clinton Street where such streets cross Southern Pacific Company tracks; that it has been determined that the city and Southern Pacific Company should install such protection and share the cost thereof equally; that the city's estimated share of the cost is the sum of \$23,750; that an agreement should be entered into between the city and Southern Pacific Company providing for such installation and allocation of costs and further providing that the railroad company will thereafter maintain the gate crossings at its own expense; now, therefore, the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement on behalf of the city with Southern Pacific Company to provide railroad crossing gate protection at S.E. 11th and 12th Avenues and S.E. Clinton Street which agreement shall generally provide that the city and Southern Pacific Company share on an equal basis the cost of installation of such protection and that thereafter the Southern Pacific Company shall maintain the gate crossings. Such agreement shall be approved as to substance by the City Engineer and the City Traffic Engineer and as to form by the City Attorney.


Section 2. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to draw and deliver a warrant or warrants in payment of the city's share of the cost of installation as referred to in Section 1 of this ordinance in accordance with the terms of the agreement herein authorized, which warrant or warrants shall be charged to the 1968-69 appropriation State Tax Street Fund 6675, Code 100.


Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that the agreement herein authorized may be entered into in the interest of public safety without unnecessary delay; therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
