Recommendations

One of the current Building External Appeal Board terms expires May 21, 2016. Portland City Code 24 requires that the Building Board of Appeal have 3 members appointed by the Mayor. All members must be qualified by experience and training to make decisions on matters pertaining to building code issues. One member and one alternate member shall be Oregon licensed architects, one member and one alternate shall be competent builders, and one member and one alternate shall be members of the public at large.

I am recommending Sam Rodriguez be reappointed to the Building Code Board of Appeal for a 2nd term to expire May 21, 2019. Sam has served the City well in his first 3 years on the Building Code Board of Appeal. He has been available for meetings and has taken his position on the board very seriously.

Outreach

The process for appointing a new board member begins with the filing of an application for membership with the Office of Neighborhood Involvement (ONI). Once ONI receives the applications and conflict of interest forms, it forwards those documents to Terry Whitehill in BDS for review. There has been active on-going recruitment for an alternate member of the board. Current Building Code Board of Appeal members notified their constituent groups of the vacant positions, and BDS included information about the vacancies in multiple issues of its *Plans Examiner* newsletter. The *Plans Examiner* is an electronic newsletter published by BDS that is widely distributed to BDS customers and stakeholders, as well as, neighborhood associations and community groups.

With this proposed reappointment, there will be two vacant alternate positions (builder and building construction expertise) remaining on the board. We are continuing our outreach efforts to fill these vacant positions.
