SUBJECT: Accept report from Design Week Portland on Designing for Civic Engagement

I am pleased to submit for your consideration a report from Design Week Portland.

Design Week Portland is a week-long, city-wide series of programs exploring the process, craft, and practice of design across all disciplines. Its mission is to increase appreciation and awareness about design and its far-reaching effects on matters of cultural and social relevance, including community development, education systems, and the economy. This past April during the Design Week Portland festival, organizers mounted an installation on Pioneer Courthouse Square to capture citizens' hopes and dreams for our neighborhoods and our city.
