

**ORDINANCE No. 187772 As Amended**

Revise sewer and stormwater rates, charges and fees in accordance with the FY 2016-2017 Sewer User Rate Study (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Mayor's Proposed Budget for the Bureau of Environmental Services for Fiscal Year 2016-2017 requires adjustments to sewer and drainage rates, charges and fees for the 12-month period beginning July 1, 2016.
2. Sewer and drainage rates, charges and fees need to be adjusted to pay the operating, maintenance, and capital costs, including debt service, of the City's sanitary sewer and stormwater drainage system.
3. In accordance with policies adopted by City Council, the proposed adjustments to sewer and drainage rates, charges and fees are based upon cost of service principles, ensuring equity by charging ratepayers according to the amount of sewer and drainage service they use.
4. The proposed sewer and drainage rates, charges and fees are consolidated into a comprehensive schedule as set forth in Exhibit A of this Ordinance. The consolidated schedule does not preclude the establishment and/or continuation of charges and fees by resolution, ordinance, Code provision or administrative rule, not otherwise specified in this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Council adopts sewer and drainage rates, charges and fees in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Sewer User Rate Study, as set forth in the attached Exhibit A; and
- b. Exhibit A of this Ordinance is binding city policy.
