

ORDINANCE No. 187775

Authorize Portland Bureau of Transportation to enter into agreements with non-City hosts for BIKETOWN bike share stations (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. On September 23, 2015 Council approved Ordinance No. 187351 enabling the Portland Bureau of Transportation (“PBOT”) to enter into the amended and restated Contract No. 30003174 Motivate International to acquire, launch and operate a bike share system (the “System”).
2. PBOT intends to launch a System of 1,000 bicycles and 100 stations in July 2016.
3. PBOT is currently amidst a public station planning process. PBOT has proposed 300 draft candidate locations and is soliciting public input to help narrow to the list to the final 100 station locations. To date, the public has provided approximately 4,600 comments on the project’s online interactive station map and through the five open houses.
4. PBOT intends to site the vast majority of stations on City-owned property. PBOT estimates that five percent or less of the stations will be located on non-City property. These hosts may be public agencies or private property owners.
5. Such non-City sites are only being considered where such sites provide a clear benefit to alternate options on City-owned property. PBOT will only pursue such agreements with willing and interested hosts. No financial compensation will be provided to any of the station hosts. The agreements will be temporary in nature.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Transportation is authorized to enter into agreements substantially similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit A to this ordinance, for potential non-City hosts of BIKETOWN bike share stations, subject to approval as to form by the Office of the City Attorney.
