Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The purpose of the proposed legislation is to authorize the Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services or designee and the City Attorney to enter into a settlement and release agreement with Jon Wiener and Julie Grandfield.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

Community impacts and community involvement:

This project was the first of three pilot projects that Environmental Services completed to keep stormwater and groundwater out of sanitary sewers in parts of the Burlingame, Fanno, and Tryon sanitary sewer basins of southwest Portland. Inflow of stormwater and infiltration of groundwater into pipes designed to convey only sanitary sewage occur either because storm drains are directly connected to the sanitary sewer or because cracks in sanitary sewer pipes allow groundwater to flow into these pipes.

This project was very sensitive as our contractors performed their work on private property through a participation agreement signed by each property owner. We currently have completed more than half of these connections and the last pilot project will involve about 180 participants.

BES has concluded that it would be feasible and reasonable to settle with Mr. Wiener and Ms. Grandfield for a sum of \$7,500. Mr. Wiener and Ms. Grandfield have agreed to sign the settlement and release form for this amount that was provided by our city attorney.
