ORDINANCE No. 187779

*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland State University for \$48,500 to research and track community development as part of the Building Healthy Connected Communities Along the Powell-Division Corridor Project. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Council approved on May 27, 2015 the Mayor's letter of application, dated May 27, 2015, City agencies to submit grant application requests for "Building Healthy, Connected Communities Along the Powell-Division Corridor.
- On May 27, 2015, the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability applied to Metro for Community Planning and Development Grants (Ordinance 187137) in the amount of \$539,000 for the "Building Healthy, Connected Communities Along the Powell-Division Corridor" project.
- 3. Metro notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the "Building Healthy, Connected Communities Along the Powell-Division Corridor" project in the amount of \$539,000.
- 4. Of the \$539,000 the City receives, \$48,500 will be passed on to Portland State University PSU), under the direction of Lisa K. Bates, Ph.D., to carry out research on bus-rapid transit improvements and its impacts on housing affordability, displacement, and carbon emissions in the Powell-Division corridor. Funds are available in the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability FY 2015-16 Revised Budget, Grant ID PN000060, cost object PN00600001.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental grant agreement with Portland State University in a form substantially similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit 1.

- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the intergovernmental agreement chargeable to the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability, Cost Object PN00600001 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
- c. The Director of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability is hereby authorized to sign amendments for continuing data management, reporting and funding in future fiscal years if appropriations are approved by City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to forward funds for services to continue work that benefits the City. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
