

ORDINANCE No. 187790

* Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement between the Office of Neighborhood Involvement East Portland Action Plan Municipal Partnership Project and Multnomah County School District No. 40 – David Douglas School District for student interpreter training workshops for \$15,171 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

SECTION 1. The Council finds:

1. In February 2009, Portland City Council adopted the East Portland Action Plan (EPAP). This plan was developed by the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability with input from key City and County agencies, community based groups and community members. The Plan includes strategies and action items in five areas, including education/learning and community building. This project is intended to address the following EPAP action strategy and item:
 - a. L.3.2: Develop connections between high school students and higher education and workforce development, such as SUN schools' business consultants;
 - b. L.4.2: Identify at-risk students and develop targeted services, alternate education opportunities through community colleges;
 - c. L.4.3: Expand cost-effective college credit program opportunities for high school students;
 - d. L.5.1: Support, promote and expand Mt. Hood Community College's presence and offerings in East Portland;
 - e. L.7.1: Increase parental involvement in and access to public K-12 schools;
 - f. L.7.2: Provide bi-lingual, bi-cultural staff at schools with large immigrant populations to serve as parent involvement coordinators and liaisons;
 - g. CB.1.2 Engage ethnic communities in neighborhood activities; provide translation/language services to remove barriers and improve messaging and invitation;
 - h. EC.4.2: Develop and build relationships between business community and other community organizations for mentoring, skill building, fundraising, and development;
 - i. EC.4.3: Develop clearing house/program to connect East Portland residents with workforce training and education programs that lead to career track, living wage jobs.
2. The EPAP FY 2015-16 Budget includes funds to be applied toward civic engagement grants, general grants, and municipal partnership projects. The EPAP Municipal Partnership Program (MPP) established criteria to award funds for projects in East Portland that address FY 2015-16 East Portland Action Plan Strategic Priorities.
3. The EPAP MPP 'Interpreter Training Workshop Series' project will allocate \$15,171 to fund Portland Multnomah County School District No. 40 – David Douglas School District (DDSD), to be applied to the cost of training and mentoring of DDSD students as interpreters who will provide home visits and involvement encouragement to families.

4. Funding for this EPAP project is included in the Office of Neighborhood Involvement FY 2015-16 budget adopted by Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a) The Director of the Office of Neighborhood Involvement and the City Auditor are authorized to execute this Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the David Douglas School District totaling \$15,171 on behalf of the City in a form substantially in accordance with the IGA attached as Exhibit A.
- b) Amendments to the grant agreement may be agreed to and executed by the Director of ONI or his/her designee provided those amendments do not increase the fiscal risk to the City.
- c) The Director of the Office of Neighborhood Involvement and the City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for said grant agreement from the Office of Neighborhood Involvement general funds.

SECTION 2. The Council declares an emergency exists in order to distribute funds for these projects and avoid interruption in the continuity of services to be provided, therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
