ORDINANCE No. 187793

*Authorize a contract with Friends of Trees for community tree education, planting, and establishment services in the amount of \$5,882,216. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

- Section 1. The Council finds:
 - 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) uses green infrastructure, including trees, to manage stormwater sustainably in service of clean rivers, healthy watersheds, and livable, sustainable communities.
 - 2. The City of Portland is committed to increasing and enhancing the urban forest canopy to provide tree benefits more equitably to meet the needs of diverse and traditionally underserved communities, to manage stormwater sustainably, and to protect human health by reducing urban heat island.
 - 3. This legislative item directly supports specific goals and objectives in the following plans Portland Watershed Management Plan, Comprehensive Plan, Central City 2035 Plan, Portland Plan, Climate Action Plan and Climate Change Preparation Strategy, and the Urban Forestry Management Plan through increased canopy coverage within the City.
 - 4. A competitive solicitation (RFP #00000221) was conducted in accordance with Chapter 5.68 of the City Code, and the evaluation committee selected Friends of Trees.
 - 5. Friends of Trees is an established and experienced non-profit organization that builds community in the City by coordinating community tree planting and tree care events who has planted over 30,000 trees in partnership with the City over the past eight years.
 - 6. The established cost is \$5,882,216 for a five-and-a-half year contract with M/W/ESB subcontractor participation of \$70,975 or 1.2% of the total contract amount. The cost estimate level of confidence rating is optimal. Funds from the General Fund and the Sewer System Operating Fund are available in the FY15-16 and FY16-17 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Internal Order #9ESWS15WR002 and are requested from the same funds for the remainder of the contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute a contract with Friends of Trees for the purposes described in Section 1, in the amount of \$5,882,216.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the General Fund and Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2.

The Council declares that an emergency exists because the outreach and education work required to deliver the contract must begin as soon as possible. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
