ORDINANCE No. 187795 As Amended

*Adopt Administrative Rules for Chapter 23.10 Removing Barriers to Employment and authorize the City Attorney to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Bureau of Labor and Industry not to exceed \$25,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On November 25, 2015, through Ordinance 187459, City Council adopted Chapter 23.10 Removing Barriers to Employment, establishing parameters for the use of criminal history information by employers within the City.
- 2. City code 23.10.050 requires that the City Attorney draft rules, procedures and forms to assist in the implementation of the provisions of the code, and bring these rules before Council for authorization.
- 3. City code 23.10.060 allows the City to contract with the Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI) to enforce Chapter 23.10.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council Directs:

- The City to adopt Administrative Rule for Chapter 23.10 Removing Barriers to Employment is adopted as shown in Exhibit A.
- The City Attorney is authorized to sign an Intergovernmental Agreement substantially similar to the attached agreement as shown in Exhibit B.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because the public welfare would be harmed if the administrative rules and intergovernmental agreement are not in place when enforcement of Chapter 23.10 commences on July 1, 2016; therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
