

ORDINANCE NO. 132005

An Ordinance amending Section 20.20.010 of the Code of the City of Portland, Oregon to increase fees for use of City-owned golf facilities and fixing a special effective date, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that because of the increase in operation and maintenance costs, it is necessary to increase the fees for the use of all City-owned golf facilities; that the new schedule of fees set out herein below has been recommended by the Superintendent of Parks and approved by the Commissioner in charge of the Bureau of Parks, and that Section 20.20.010 of the Code of the City of Portland should be amended to increase said fees, effective February 1, 1971; now, therefore, Section 20.20.010 of the Code of the City of Portland, Oregon hereby is amended to read as follows:

20.20.010 Playing rates. The following rates shall be charged and collected for the privilege of playing golf on the Eastmoreland, Rose City, and Progress Downs Golf Courses:

For each round of nine holes or less, on week days	<u>\$1.75</u>
For each round of nine holes or less, on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays	<u>2.50</u>
<u>Except that an 18-hole ticket on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays may be purchased for</u>	<u>4.50</u>
For players who hold a valid membership card in the city Junior Golf Club and who have passed their ninth birthday but who have not passed their eighteenth birthday, the rate for nine holes shall be	.75
This "junior" rate shall not apply until after one o'clock p.m. on any Saturday, Sunday or holiday.	
For college golf team members during inter-collegiate tournament competition only for each nine holes or less	<u>1.00</u>

Greens fee for Delta Park Golf Course shall be twenty-five cents greater for each nine holes or less in all categories, except for junior play and intercollegiate tournaments as stated elsewhere herein.

The rate for annual commutation tickets permitting unlimited play on any day of the year and valid from July 1 of each year to June 30 of the following calendar year shall be sixty dollars, and in addition the holder of such ticket shall pay a greens fee of \$1.25 per nine

holes, except that on Saturday, Sunday or holiday the greens fee shall be one dollar and seventy-five cents.

In addition to the annual commutation ticket herein provided, a special semi-annual ticket may be issued to persons sixty-five years of age or older. The cost of said special semi-annual commutation ticket shall be fifty-one dollars but will not be valid on Saturday, Sunday or holiday between April 1 and September 30 until after one p.m.

In addition to the appropriate greens fee, the following rate shall be charged for the privilege of operating a motorized golf cart on a city-owned golf course, when such use is permitted:

For each round of 18 holes or less \$1.00

Players shall be restricted to not less than eighteen holes of play on Saturdays, Sundays, or holidays between the hours of seven a.m. and eleven a.m.

Exception: Nine hole tickets may be purchased for play on the back nine only on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays for a period of one hour after daylight (or until the first group playing eighteen holes reaches the eighth green).

All greens fees, including annual and semi-annual tickets, must be paid in full in advance. No refund will be granted on any rates herein established. All tickets issued in accordance with the above schedule are a permit to play the game of golf, issued to a single individual on the date of issue, and shall not be transferable. The privilege of playing under any rate established herein may be suspended or terminated and canceled immediately without refund by the commissioner in charge for any violation of course rules or regulations, or for any conduct which interferes with the proper administration of the golf course or its enjoyment by the public.

The following rates shall be charged for the privilege of using the facilities of any city golf driving range:

<u>For each bucket of approximately fifteen</u> <u>golf balls</u>	<u>\$.25</u>
For each bucket of approximately fifty golf balls	.75
<u>For each bucket of approximately one hun-</u> <u>dred golf balls</u>	<u>1.50</u>

For each golf club rented \$.25

The following rates shall be charged for the privilege of using the facilities of the Hoyt Park Pitch and Putt Golf Course of the city:


For each round of eighteen holes or less \$1.25

For each golf club rented for eighteen holes .25

Section 2. The new fees authorized by this ordinance shall be effective as of February 1, 1971.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that the new rates may be established without undue delay as described in Section 1 hereof, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
