

ORDINANCE NO. 132504

An Ordinance authorizing the City to make application to the Department of Housing and Urban Development for a grant-in-aid of acquisition of the Old George School Site, authorizing contracts pursuant thereto, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that pursuant to Title VII of the Housing Act of 1961 as amended, the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development is authorized to make grants to local public bodies to assist them in the acquisition and development of permanent interest in land for open space uses where such assistance is needed to carry out a unified or officially coordinated program for the preservation and development of an open space plan as a part of the comprehensively planned development of the urban area; that there is a need within the City for additional open space in north Portland at or about the Old George School Site; that if a grant is made to the City for acquisition and development of such open space land, the grant will impose certain obligations and responsibilities upon the City which will include provision of one-half the cost thereof which is now estimated to be \$25,000; that it appears that said local share will be available to the City from funds available from land sold to the school district and the balance thereof from the Park Land Acquisition Fund; now, therefore, for aid in acquisition and development of the Old George School Site in north Portland, the Commissioner of Public Affairs hereby is authorized to make application to the Department of Housing and Urban Development for a grant-in-aid of acquisition and development, cost of acquisition now estimated to be \$50,000; and should said grant be approved, the Mayor and Commissioner of Public Affairs are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the City contracts with the Department of Housing and Urban Development as may be required for said grants.

Section 2. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is hereby authorized to give assurance to the Department of Housing and Urban Development that the City will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the regulations of the Department of Housing and Urban Development effectuating that title providing that no person will be discriminated against because of race, color, or national origin in the use of said land.


Section 3. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is hereby authorized to give the Department of Housing and Urban Development such information as may be required by the Department for its consideration of said grant.


