Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

City Code 2.08.120 requires the City Elections Officer to proclaim to the City Council the candidates nominated or elected and the measures approved at each City election. This report provides the official results of the municipal election held May 17, 2016 in the City of Portland as reported by Multnomah, Clackamas, and Washington County certified elections results and proclaims individuals elected and nominated and measures passed.

City Code 2.04.090 requires calculation of a percentage of electors at each regular primary election to determine new petition signature minimums. These new numbers are included on the report.

Note: a separate Council item will be read as the formal proclamation of measure 26-173.
