ORDINANCE NO. 187817

* Amend subrecipient contract with Transition Projects to add \$348,500 for additional rent assistance for housing placement and prevention, emergency shelter staffing and operations, and the Rent Well Landlord Guarantee Fund (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 32001169)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that:

- 1. As part of the City of Portland's declared State of Emergency for housing and homelessness, the Portland City Council is investing \$2,064,226 in City General Funds for additional rent assistance and to expand shelter capacity. These activities align with strategies identified in *A Home for Everyone: A United Community Plan to End Homelessness in Multnomah County*.
- 2. The City of Portland, acting through its Portland Housing Bureau (PHB), has been the primary funder of key strategies and services of *A Home for Everyone* and the State of Emergency.
- 3. PHB desires to amend the existing Contract No. 32001169 to add \$348,500 for additional rent assistance for housing placement and prevention (\$140,000); housing for Veterans (\$32,500), Rent Well landlord guarantee fund (\$40,000), and Jerome Sears shelter staffing and operations (\$136,000).
- 4. The funding for housing placement and prevention was approved in Ordinance No. 187700.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs that:

- a. The Bureau Director is hereby authorized to enter into a contract amendment with Transition Projects in a form similar to the amendment attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Portland Housing Bureau's operating fund budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in implementing the authorized amendment and associated program would place people experiencing homelessness at increased risk of illness or injury. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
