* Amend contract with Bicycle Transportation Alliance for Safe Routes to School bicycle and pedestrian safety education for an amount not to exceed \$300,000 (Ordinance, amend Contract No. 30002664)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- The Portland Safe Routes to School is a partnership of the City of Portland, schools, neighborhoods, community organizations and agencies that implements programs that makes walking and biking around our neighborhoods and schools fun, easy, safe and healthy for all students and families.
- The Portland Safe Routes to School program has demonstrated success, having recruited over 100 partner schools throughout the city since its inception and increasing walking and biking rates at those schools from 31% in 2006 to 43% in 2015.
- 3. The Portland Safe Routes to School program has provided bicycle and pedestrian safety programming to students since its inception in 2005.
- The Bicycle Transportation Alliance was selected through a competitive bid process to provide bicycle and pedestrian safety services at Safe Routes to School partner schools.
- 5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is moderate.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to amend Contract No. 30002664 between the Bicycle Transportation Alliance and the City of Portland as outlined in a form similar to the contract amendment attached as Exhibit A. Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the current contract expired on June 30, 2016; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
