## **ORDINANCE No.** 187820

Amend Intergovernmental Agreement with Oregon Department of Transportation for design of the Burgard/Lombard at North Time Oil Road project (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30003916)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On August 17, 2011, the Portland City Council passed Resolution No. 36876, as Amended, nominating the Burgard/Lombard at North Time Oil Road Intersection Improvement project for FY 2014-15 Regional Flexible Funds.
- 2. The Portland Bureau of Transportation applied for a Transportation Enhancement (TE) Grant in the amount of \$2,635,000 on September of 2011 for the Burgard/Lombard at North Time Oil Road project.
- 3. On May 19, 2014, Council approved Ordinance No. 186503 that authorized a grant funding that covered the total anticipated cost for engineering and right-of-way of the project, estimated at approximately \$2,635,000.
- 4. Amendment #1 will certify the City of Portland Bureau of Transportation to bid and construct this project as a certification project using federal funds.
- 5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is moderate. We are at 95% design and are developing the final estimate.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to execute an amendment, approved as to form by the city Attorney, with Oregon Department of Transportation for the Burgard/Lombard at North Time Oil Road project, in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
