ORDINANCE No. 187824

* Authorize a grant agreement with LifeWorks NW for the use of U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance Grant Program funds in an amount not to exceed \$220,000 for agency personnel expenses for the New Options for Women program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City is the recipient of U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance FFY14 and FFY15 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program grant funds to provide funding to LifeWorks NW, which operates New Options for Women (NOW), a program specifically designed to meet the needs of prostituted women;
- 2. LifeWorks NW partners with the Police Bureau East Precinct Sex Trafficking Unit (STU) and the Multnomah County Deputy District Attorney (DDA). LifeWorks NW provides services to help victims seek alternatives to sex work, cope with underlying causes of their behavior, and address addiction issues;
- 3. A condition of the grant program requires the City to serve as fiscal agent for subawardees. The City, as the Pass-Through-Entity (PTE), will reimburse LifeWorks NW for all approved grant program expenses not to exceed \$220,000;
- 4. The agreement shall begin July 1, 2015, and extend through December 31, 2018, or until grant funds are exhausted; and
- 5. Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the grant program work approved by DOJ.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to execute a Grant Agreement in a form similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Chief of Police and the grant project manager are authorized to execute amendments to the scope of services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the amount of compensation or increase the City's financial risk.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the grant program work approved by DOJ. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
