**Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:**

This legislation authorizes a Grant Agreement (GRA) with LifeWorks NW (LNW) in order to pay for FY16 program expenses, \$100,000 as directed by Council. The Police Bureau's 2015 JAG grant will fund \$110,000 of the New Options for Women (NOW) personnel expenses addressed in a separate Grant Agreement.

**Financial and budgetary impacts:** The Grant Agreements replace the PTE contract as the appropriate funding instrument in order for LifeWorks to receive FY 2015-16 PPB budgeted funding as directed by Council.

**Community impacts and community involvement:** There are no legal or controversial issues. There is no voluntary citizen participation. There are no links to current City policies.
