ORDINANCE No. 187826

* Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the State of Oregon for the use of U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance FFY 2015 National Sexual Assault Kit Initiative Grant Program funds of \$125,657 for grant program expenses (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) awarded the City a grant for the FFY 2015 National Sexual Assault Kit Initiative (SAKI) Grant Program in the amount of \$1,189,790;
- 2. The SAKI Grant Program addresses the issue of unsubmitted sexual assault kits at the Portland Police Bureau;
- 3. Council authorized acceptance of the grant award on October 14, 2015;
- 4. A condition of the grant program requires the City to serve as fiscal agent for subgrantees and contractors. The City wishes to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the State of Oregon Department of State Police Crime Laboratory (OSP) to obligate agency roles and responsibilities as related to the 2015 SAKI Grant Program;
- 5. The City will, with DOJ OJP BJA grant funds, reimburse OSP for all approved program expenses not to exceed \$125,657;
- 6. The agreement shall begin April 1, 2016, and extend through September 30, 2018, or until grant funds are exhausted; and
- 7. Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the grant program work approved by DOJ.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement in a form similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Management Division is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

c. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland, or the Grant Program Manager, is authorized to accept on behalf of the City any subsequent modifications by OJP for the FFY 2015 National Sexual Assault Kit Initiative Grant (SAKI) Program, #2015-AK-BX-K020, provided such modifications do not increase the City's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by Council.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the grant program work approved by DOJ. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
