## ORDINANCE No. 187834

\*Authorize grant agreement with Portland Community Reinvestment Initiatives Inc. for \$230,000 to fund the North/Northeast Community Development Pathway 1000 Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds that:

- 1. Bureau of Planning and Sustainability applied to Metro for a Community Planning and Development Grant (Ordinance 187137) in the amount of \$250,000 for the North/Northeast Community Development Pathway 1000 Initiative Project on May 27, 2015.
- 2. The application received letters of support from nonprofit organizations doing work with minority populations in North and Northeast Portland, and from the Portland Housing Bureau
- 3. Metro notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the North/Northeast Community Development Pathway 1000 Initiative Project to Bureau of Planning and Sustainability in the amount of \$250,000, approving the Portland Community Reinvestment Initiative to be a collaborator on the project.
- 4. Council approved and accepted the grant award (Ordinance 187640) on March 23, 2016, and execute IGA with Metro for the North/Northeast Community Development Pathway 1000 Project (Contract No. 30005018).

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is authorized to enter into a Grant Agreement with Portland Community Reinvestment Initiative (PCRI) as outlined in form substantially similar with the agreement attached as Exhibit 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to pay invoices in the amount of \$28,000 to PN000063 chargeable to the Fiscal Year 2015-16 Budget, and \$222,000 chargeable to the Fiscal Year 2016-17 Budget.

- c. The Director of Bureau of Planning and Sustainability of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications for the PCRI grant, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk.
- d. The City Council hereby waives the competitive application process for grants as required in FIN 2.04 Budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists so that the City and PCRI can meet the timelines in the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
