TO THE COUNCIL:

Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) is Oregon's largest fire and emergency services provider. PF&R provides fire, medical (emergency medical service), and special response services to nearly 600,000 people within an area of approximately 152 square miles. PF&R operates 28 engine companies, two quint companies and nine truck companies as well as specialized rescue units, providing emergency services 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to a wide range of occupancy types including residential, high-rises, commercial / industrial, institutional including schools and hospitals, etc. PF&R currently maintains a Class 2 rating (on a scale of 1-10) from the Insurance Service Organization (ISO). PF&R's equipment must be maintained and upgraded as needs and requirements of the City change in order to maintain this Class rating.

Portland City Council passed Ordinance 187739 on May 11, 2016, authorizing the purchase of two (2) pieces of emergency apparatus, and PF&R wishes to purchase two (2) tiller aerial fire trucks from Pierce Manufacturing, Inc.

In accordance with City Code 5.33.170, the City may participate in Interstate Cooperative Procurements to establish contracts or price agreements for the acquisition of goods or services. Houston-Galveston Area Council has conducted a competitive solicitation and executed Contract #FS12-15 with Pierce Manufacturing, Inc., for the purchase of Aerials (Booms/Platforms, Ladders, Ladder/Platforms) (NH 620 XT Arrow Tiller Apparatus). The contract as executed by Houston-Galveston Area Council allows governmental agencies to utilize the contract for the purchase of such equipment.

On June 6, 2016, in accordance with PCC 5.33.170, the City posted a Notice of Intent to Award an Interstate Cooperative Procurement. No comments were received.

Pierce Manufacturing, Inc., has a current City of Portland Business License Tax Account, is in full compliance with the Equal Benefits Program and EEO Certification. Pierce Manufacturing, Inc., is not a State of Oregon Certified MWESB contractor. The level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is Moderate based on a price quote received from Pierce Manufacturing, Inc.
