### CONSENT CALENDAR

TO THE COUNCIL:

On May 4, 2016, Council approved Ordinance 187708 directing Procurement Services to competitively solicit the Portland Communications Center Seismic Upgrade, Roof Replacement, Mechanical Upgrades, and Envelope Repair Project in accordance with PCC 5.34. The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received bids for Bid Number 00000291 on behalf of the Bureau of Business Internal Services – Facilities (BIBS), with a project construction estimate of \$2,093,062.00. BIBS rated the Project Estimate confidence level as Optimal.

Bids were due and opened on May 10, 2016, and one (1) bid was received. The bid of Skyward Construction, Inc. was responsive to the solicitation requirements, thus the Chief Procurement Officer recommends that Skyward Construction, Inc.'s bid to be accepted at the estimated unit prices quoted for a total bid amount of \$2,786,000.00.

BIBS along with Procurement Services identified six (6) Divisions of Work as potential subcontracting opportunities for this project, resulting in \$331,000.00 awarded to subcontractors.

In their bid, Skyward Construction, Inc. indicated their intent to self-perform the following Divisions of Work:

At bid time, MWESB participation was a zero. Working with the City, Skyward Construction was able to increase MWESB participation to 20.7% or \$331,000 of the estimated subcontracting dollars.

• MBE - \$260,000 performing Drywall and Paint.

Skyward Contraction, Inc. is located in Ridgefield, WA. Skyward as the Prime Contractor will be self-performing the Carpentry, Drywall, HVAC, Painting, Roofing and Structural Steel for a total of \$2,455,000. Total M/WBE prime and subcontracting dollars equal \$260,000.00, or 9.3% of the total bid. They have a current City of Portland Business Tax Registration and EEO Certification, and are in Full Compliance with the Equal Benefits Program.

Funds are available in BIBS Owner Cost Centers MFOP000042.

It is recommended that the Performance and Payment Bonds each at 100% of the contract amount be furnished by the Contractor. Further, it is also recommended that a two (2) year Maintenance/Warranty Bond for 20% of the final contract amount be furnished by the Contractor before final payment is released.
