The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Ordinance 187791 passed Council on June 8th to extend the current suspension of systems development charges for Parks and Recreation, as directed by Resolution No. 37201.
- 2. The ordinance passed, but Exhibit A contained an error; the SDC fee structure included was not the correct one that will be in effect July 1, 2016, per Ordinance 187150 as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Ordinance No. 187791 attached hereto is amended to replace Exhibit A with the corrected Exhibit A.
- b. All other terms and provisions of Ordinance No. 187791 remain the same and are not affected by this amendment.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to comply with the Council directives of Resolution No. 37201, and eliminate barriers to the achievement of City density and affordable housing goals; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
