ORDINANCE No. 187877 As Amended

*Authorize a contract with Versaterm, Inc. for maintenance of the Regional Justice Information Network in an amount not to exceed \$3,790,000 over a five-year term (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On September 17, 2008, the Council passed Ordinance No. 182216 authorizing a competitive Request for Proposal for the Portland Police Data System Records Management System Replacement Project, also known as the Regional Justice Information Network (RegJIN).
- 2. On May 17, 2013, following the successful completion of the competitive procurement, Council accepted the recommendation of the Chief Procurement Officer's Report to Council and authorized the execution of a contract with Versaterm, Inc., which was executed effective June 28, 2013.
- 3. Versaterm provided one year of warranty support for RegJIN, starting with final system acceptance on July 14, 2015. The City wishes to continue to receive technical support from Versaterm under a separately executed Maintenance Agreement as set forth in the original contract with Versaterm.
- 4. Approximately one third of necessary funding will come from existing Police Bureau General Fund resources and approximately two thirds will come from the RegJIN Regional Partner Agencies.
- 5. Procurement authority for this maintenance contract is via Special Procurement in accordance with City Code 5.33.D.12.
- 6. It is beneficial to the City and community that this agreement may be authorized as quickly as possible to avoid a lapse in the program.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

a. The City's Chief Procurement Officer is hereby authorized to execute and amend a contract with Versaterm, Inc. for a total not-to-exceed value of \$3,790,000 for a five-year term, provided the form has been approved by the City Attorney's Office.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the City needs to act promptly to ensure continuity of the maintenance and support services and to enable the Portland Police Bureau and its regional partner agencies to continue activities dependent upon use of RegJIN.

Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
