

ORDINANCE NO. 187895

Authorize a contract with TRC Pipeline Services, LLC not to exceed \$400,000 for condition survey and assessment services of the Bull Run Supply Conduits (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City needs to retain the professional, technical and expert services of a pipeline integrity management consultant to survey and analyze the performance and condition of the cathodic protection system for the conduits that transport water from the Bull Run Watershed to in-town reservoirs and provide recommendations for maintenance and upgrades to the system.
2. A formal Request for Proposal was conducted (RFP 00000159) in accordance with Chapter 5.68 of the Code of the City of Portland.
3. Five proposals were received in response to the Request for Proposal. An evaluation committee selected a consultant based on an evaluation of proposals received in accordance with Chapter 5.68. The committee included staff from the Water Bureau and members of the community, including a minority evaluator in accordance with the City's Minority Evaluator Program.
4. TRC Pipeline Services, LLC was the highest scoring proposer and was selected by the evaluation committee as the most responsive and responsible consultant. A notice of intent to negotiate and award a contract was posted to the City of Portland BuySpeed on February 23, 2016.
5. There are a limited number of firms capable of performing the specialized work required and the subcontracting opportunities are limited.
6. Currently there are no Minority, Women, and Emerging Small Business (M/W/ESB) subconsultants assigned to the contract. However, there is one subconsultant that is in the process of obtaining their State of Oregon Emerging Small Business certification. Should further subcontracting opportunities arise in the project they will be pursued.
7. The not-to-exceed amount of the contract is \$400,000. Funding for services required under the contract have been approved in the FY 2016-17 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to execute on behalf of the City a contract with TRC Pipeline Services, LLC to provide survey and analytical services in a form substantially in accordance with the contract attached as Exhibit A.


- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Water Fund when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.


