TO THE COUNCIL:

On May 4, 2016, Council approved Ordinance 187709 directing Procurement Services to competitively solicit the Smart Park & North Precinct Repair and Recoating Project in accordance with PCC 5.34. The Chief Procurement Officer advertised and received bids for Bid Number 00000298 on behalf of the Bureau of Internal Business Services – Facilities (BIBS). The project construction estimate was \$1,567,355.00 and BIBS rated the Project Estimate confidence level as Optimal.

Bids were due and opened on June 2, 2016, and two (2) bids were received. The bid of FD Thomas, Inc. was responsive to the solicitation requirements, thus the Chief Procurement Officer recommends that FD Thomas, Inc.'s bid be accepted at the lump sum prices quoted for a total bid amount of \$1,095,093.00.

BIBS along with Procurement Services identified one (1) Division of Work as potential subcontracting opportunities for this project, resulting in \$26,580.00 awarded to subcontractors.

The Divisions of Work identified were:

Striping	
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The Smart Park & N Precinct Repair and Recoating project is highly specialized work that required the Prime Contractor to submit a Special Prequalification application to show the Contractor had sufficient experience in doing this type of work. Because the work is so specialized, the Prime Contractor must perform the specialized work in order to achieve and maintain the warranties required. Because of the nature of the work very few subcontracting opportunities were available. The Prime Contractor has agreed to subcontract all of the work available to be subcontracted and at bid time, MWESB participation represented 100% or \$26,580.00 of the estimated subcontracting dollars.

MBE - \$26,580.00 performing Striping.

FD Thomas, Inc. is located in Central Point, Oregon. FD Thomas as the Prime Contractor will be self-performing the repairs and recoating of the garages for a total of \$1,095,093. They have a current City of Portland Business Tax Registration and EEO Certification, and are in Full Compliance with the Equal Benefits Program.

Procurement Services recommends that the Contractor furnish Performance and Payment Bonds each at 100% of the contract amount. Further, it is also recommended that the Contractor furnish a two (2) year Maintenance /Warranty Bond for 20% of the final contract amount before final payment is released.
