Legislation title: *Pay claims of Kyle Aukland and Meghan Graham for the total sum of \$43,227 involving the Police Bureau. (Ordinance)

Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

This ordinance will close OMF Risk Management file numbers 2014-001182-30 and 2014-001184-30, which arise from injuries sustained by Kyle Aukland and Meghan Graham in a motor vehicle collision with the Portland Police that occurred on September 7, 2014 at SE 82nd Avenue and SE Powell.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

This legislation will have no impact on City revenue.

Total cost to the City is \$43,226.71. The source of funding is the City’s Insurance and Claims Fund. \$6,149.25 of this total was paid by Risk Management in FY 2015-2016. The remaining \$37,077.46 will be paid in FY 2016-2017. This Ordinance does not amend the budget.

Community impacts and community involvement:

This Ordinance settles two tort claims resulting from a motor vehicle collision involving driver Kyle Aukland and passenger Meghan Graham, and the Portland Police Bureau in SE Portland. Aukland and Graham each suffered injuries as a result.

No public involvement or input was sought regarding the Ordinance. The City Attorney’s Office and Risk Management have concluded that it is not appropriate to have public involvement in settlement negotiations regarding tort claims or lawsuits against the City.

No future public involvement is anticipated or necessary. Approval by City Council of this Ordinance will fully resolve this tort claim against the City of Portland.
