ORDINANCE No. 187901

*Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$35,700 from Oregon Department of Environmental Quality to support deconstruction workforce training and authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. On June 16, 2016 DEQ notified the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability that it will provide a grant to support the Workforce Development Training program for the amount of \$35,700.
- 2. On February 17, 2016, Council approved Resolution No. 37190 directing the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability to develop code language to require deconstruction for the city's oldest and most historic houses and ensure that adequate deconstruction training is available.
- 3. The Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has authority under ORS 459A.120 to fund activities to reduce the environmental and human health impacts of materials at all stages of their life cycles, including demonstrating activities.
- 4. No City of Portland match is required.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept and execute on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from DEQ for the Workforce Training Support in the amount of \$35,700 and to execute an intergovernmental agreement in a form similar to the agreement attached as Attachment 1.
- b. The FY 2016-17 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund 217

Business Area – PN

Bureau Program Expenses- \$35,700

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Management Division is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Director of BPS of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by DEQ for grant, award number 104-16, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
