ORDINANCE No. 187903

*Authorize a multi-year Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County for vector control services for an estimated annual amount of \$277,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services has an ongoing need for vector control services for the City's wastewater and stormwater collection and treatment systems. These services include monitoring and control of rats and mosquitoes in the Bureau's facilities, and citizen complaint investigation and response.
- 2. The Multnomah County Health Department is committed to providing these Public Health services and is able to do so.
- A multi-year agreement with the County to provide these services, based on administratively 3. adopted work plans and annually approved appropriation, would improve administrative efficiency without impairing Council's fiscal control.
- 4. The estimated cost is \$277,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY2016-17 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Cost Center ESWW000003, Account No. 529000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with a. Multnomah County for provision of vector control services to the Bureau of Environmental Services through June 30, 2021, with compensation subject to annual appropriation.
- b. Compensation to Multnomah County for services provided under this agreement not to exceed \$277,000 for the 2016-2017 fiscal year.
- The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the c. Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay would jeopardize vital public services. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
