ORDINANCE No. 187908

Authorize a grant agreement with Clackamas Community College in the amount of \$12,000 for production of a pedestrian safety Public Service Announcement in partnership with Representative Jeff Reardon, Clackamas Community College and Clackamas County (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. People walking in Portland are especially vulnerable. According to 2004-2013 crash data, 9% of travel in Portland is done by people walking; however, 31% of traffic deaths are people walking.
- 2. Education used in combination with engineering and enforcement is a proven, national best-practices strategy to reduce crashes on area roadways.
- 3. The City of Portland has made a Vision Zero commitment of zero fatalities and zero serious injuries by 2025 through better education, strategic enforcement, and engineering safer streets.
- 4. A pedestrian safety Public Service Announcement will better inform people walking about pedestrian safety and safe behaviors when crossing the street.
- 5. The City now desires to provide a grant to Clackamas Community College in an amount not to exceed \$12,000 for FY 2016-17.
- 6. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is 100%.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to enter into a Grant Agreement with Clackamas Community College as outlined in a form similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payment in the amount of \$12,000 to Clackamas Community College chargeable to the Fiscal Year 2016-17.
- c. That the City Council waives the competitive application process required in FIN 2.04 Budget.
