

## ORDINANCE No.

187910

\* Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Metro for Regional Illegal Dumping Patrol services (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Illegal dumpsites attract rats, insects, and other vermin which may also pose a health risk. There is also a high risk of physical injury from items with dangerous protruding nails or sharp edges in addition to possible harmful chemicals or other hazardous materials.
2. Since 1993, Metro has worked closely with other local government agencies and law enforcement to quickly and thoroughly investigate and remove illegal dumps.
3. Metro's RID Patrol provides illegal dump cleanup services on publicly owned land.
4. Fines from Metro's RID Patrol investigations cover the cost of cleaning up and properly managing waste from dump sites. Multnomah County inmate crews assigned to Metro from the Inverness jail clean up the sites throughout much of the region.
5. The City wishes to contract with Metro to remove solid waste at camping sites established by homeless individuals on public property, to be performed by inmate work crews supervised and provided under contract to Metro by the Multnomah County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) and the Oregon Department of Corrections (ODOC).
6. It is beneficial to the City and community that this agreement may be authorized as quickly as possible to avoid a delay in the cleanup of illegal dumping sites.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-charge is authorized to execute an agreement between the City and Metro as outlined in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Chief of Police is authorized to execute amendments to the scope of services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the amount of compensation or increase the City's financial risk.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the City needs to act promptly to ensure illegal dump sites are addressed. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
