Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

This proposed legislation authorizes entering into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with Multnomah County to pay for a feasibility study around Pay for Success (PFS) funding models to support the local expansion of affordable housing interventions that provide long term health outcomes for low-income households.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

Grant resources awarded to the City of Portland in the amount of \$96,999 are being passed through to Multnomah County, which is well positioned to conduct the PFS feasibility analysis given their current relationships and data sharing agreements already in place with medical providers, insurers, and the Oregon Medicaid office.

Community impacts and community involvement:

The PFS feasibility analysis will engage community organizations that provide direct housing interventions to low-income households which also provide long term health impacts in the community. If PFS proves to be a potential funding model, it will increase resources for housing interventions in the community.
