

ORDINANCE No. 187912

*Adopt interim rules governing Ankeny Alley and Plaza during demonstration period to inform future citywide public spaces rules (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Council passed Ordinance No. 184690 in June 2011 authorizing the closure of SW Ankeny Street between SW 2nd and SW 3rd Avenues as a pilot program to make this a unique public space.
2. In December 2011, City Council made this closure ongoing through Ordinance No. 185073 granting permission to have seating for abutting property owners, business owners, and their customers and found that granting permission was not detrimental to the public interest.
3. In 2015, the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) moved forward with restriping the intersection of SW 3rd and Ankeny to create additional space where the sidewalk is particularly narrow and the area has high levels of pedestrian congestion.
4. Additionally, the Portland Development Commission provided a grant to the adjacent property owners to create a distinctive space utilizing Ankeny Alley and the adjacent area on SW 3rd Avenue.
5. In conjunction with pursuing this demonstration project for Ankeny Plaza, PBOT is also pursuing a citywide strategy for allowing for and making accessible the ability for the community, property owners, and business owners to create their own unique spaces. This citywide approach and process will take the time necessary to finalize the necessary details for such a program.
6. In the interim, PBOT is seeking to utilize the Ankeny Alley & Plaza demonstration project to inform the citywide process, but also to refine the rules governing the public spaces.
7. As a starting point for interim rules, PBOT modelled these rules on the existing Portland Parks & Recreation rules as well as the Fire Fighters Memorial rules and PBOT's interim rules are attached as exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to establish PBOT's interim rules for Ankeny Alley & Plaza, in a form similar to the rules attached as Exhibit A, until such time as final citywide rules are in place after a robust public process.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because PBOT desires the rules to be in place upon completion of the plaza elements therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
