**Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:**

The Bureau of Transportation is undertaking a citywide process to enable the creation of innovative public spaces. In the interim, PBOT is utilizing the Ankeny Alley & Plaza demonstration as a key learning tool and to show the possibilities of how these unique public spaces can be operated. PBOT is seeking to implement rules for the plaza, modelled on existing rules in city bureaus, to enable the plaza to be functional and well maintained.

These rules would be interim until the citywide process is completed at which time final rules for public spaces will be adopted.

Community involvement has focused heavily on adjacent property owners and Old Town Chinatown neighbors as well as the downtown neighborhood.
