* Authorize a contract with Nelson\Nygaard Consulting Associates, Inc. for the development of a Livable Streets Strategy in the amount of \$149,158 (Ordinance; Contract No. 30005341)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- The City of Portland's Draft 2035 Plan calls for designing, managing and repurposing Portland streets to create opportunities for a variety of community functions.
- 2. The Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) is proposing to develop a Livable Streets Strategy to create a framework and process for community uses of the right-of-way.
- 3. A Livable Streets Strategy will support innovation in the public right-of-way by opening Portland's streets, parking spaces, plazas, and alleys to a range of events, programming, and physical infrastructure that reinforce the idea that public streets are public places to be enjoyed by all ages and abilities.
- 4. The Livable Streets Strategy will include a programmatic and regulatory framework to inform PBOT's planning, permitting, and management of placemaking projects in the right of way. This work will also include developing recommendations for how to encourage and streamline citizen initiated projects.
- 5. Nelson Nygaard was selected through a competitive bid process for the development of a Livable Streets Strategy.
- 6. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is high because the price and scope were negotiated with the firm.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to execute a contract between Nelson Nygaard and the City of Portland as outlined in a form similar to the contract amendment attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because both the consultant and PBOT are ready to begin work on the project therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
